Item 2. <u>FEMA LOMAR Request</u>. FEMA request for \$9,000 review fee to review District's responses to FEMA's comments.

Included within the engineer's report under item 1., B. is Review FEMA comment letter on the District's submitted LOMR application dated February 24, 2017, seek Board of Trustees approval for review fee of \$9,000 and also discuss general tone and responses to comments. Mr. Neudeck's further comments that with respect to this matter FEMA is asking for \$9,000 to review the District's submittal to them. He noted that there is a new software package that needs to be used and the results from this software will produce similar conclusions to the other software used. He also noted that within their data base, they claim that 5 Mile Slough does not exist and Mr. Neudeck notes that 5 Mile Slough is an accredited levee. Overall, he feels the comments received were very structured and to the point and he feels good about the comments received. He thinks the request for the \$9,000 should be approved. When asked if other requests

for funds had come in from FEMA on this project, Mr. Neudeck responded that no, this is the first request for funds on the LOMR from FEMA. If the Trustees do approve this, the engineers could also contract them while in the process to revise the lake maps.
